In addition to his activities as a composer and conductor he has lectured extensively and is author of articles on new music and aesthetics.

Currently he teaches Composition and Harmony at National Catholic University of Salta (Argentina), conduct the Academic Orchestra "José Lo Giudice", the Ensemble de Solistas of contemporary music, and Qhirghiña ensemble of Tarkas (Traditional instruments from South-America)
